GSRC's professionals, trained in conservation biology, landscape ecology, zoology, botany, forestry, wildlife management, and geographic information systems (GIS), have experience in planning and implementing a variety of sensitive species survey, monitoring, and ecosystem planning projects across the United States. GSRC's staff have received special training in survey techniques and protocols for a number of threatened and endangered species, including Mexican spotted owl, gopher tortoise, southwestern willow flycatcher, flat-tailed horned lizard, red-cockaded woodpecker, western burrowing owl, Chiricahua leopard frog, cactus ferruginous pygmy-owl, and western yellow-billed cuckoo. GSRC's professionals also have extensive experience with compliance with environmental laws and regulations specific to protected species.

GSRC has successful, long-standing relationships with the various USFWS Ecological Services Offices and NOAA Fisheries staff throughout the U.S. and with most state natural resources agencies that administer protected species regulations and programs. Consequently, GSRC's biologists are extremely knowledgeable of not only the survey protocols or management requirements, but also with the agencies' expectations and standards associated with surveys, identification of potential impacts, development of off-setting measures, and management activities.
